WELCOME - Liz

Liz thanked everyone in attendance, shared our meeting agenda, and reviewed the January minutes.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES - Liz

Minutes reviewed on screen and they were also posted to the membership via MemberHub and announced in weekly newsletter.

Motion to approve minutes was made and properly seconded.

Minutes approved unanimously via voice vote.

TREASURER'S REPORT - Barbara

Reviewed checking, money market, and current account balances. There was not much change from our January meeting.

We made a large technology purchase and paid out some staff grants.

We will contact the art teacher about the budget line the PTA has for that class as well as contact Ms. Davis about CAPS budget.

June 6, 2022 is the last day to submit for reimbursement.

RE-BUDGET PLAN - Liz

We had a very successful unfundraiser and would like to update our budget and allocate some funds to a new project.

The PTA is proposing that we look at allocating \$4,000-5000 to playground upgrades. Ms Sledge recently had a group called Play Works come out to look at the playspace so we will take those into account when those suggestions come in. Currently we are thinking of smaller soccer goals so we could have half the field used for soccer and the other half for another game, getting a second basketball goal, getting general use balls to keep in the playpod for all teachers to access.

We are also considering adding about \$500 more to our teacher appreciation budget.

Playworks, national nonprofit that helps schools rethink recess, did observations and will share suggestions about way to included more directed play and to reduce unstructured play.

Boy Scout Troop has contacted Forest View about doing a project for the school.

Ms. Davis is looking for help with Earth Day events but there are no details yet. Please contact her if you have ideas or can assist.

Car line update - Most parents follow the guidelines and expectations. The District transportation staff did observations and they are developing a plan that they will share with us.

A: We have not discussed specifics yet but accessibility and inclusivity will guide the overall vision.
